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Horses, Hearts & Heroes

On June 7, 2010, the dream of offering EAAT (Equine Assisted Activities and Therapy) programs for veterans with disabilities became a reality at BEAMING. Therapeutic riding lessons are now being conducted by a NARHA Certified Instructor who has specialty training in the NARHA program, “Horses for Heroes”. All participants, as well as the side-walkers, are veterans. Goals of the program include: improving self-esteem, coping with civilian life and stressors, and improving physical, social and behavioral skills through therapeutic horse-back riding. Riders may have diagnoses including, but not limited to: amputations, burns, spinal cord injury, traumatic brain injury, other traumatic injuries, anxiety, depression and post-traumatic stress.



BEAMING, Inc. charges a small annual registration fee and a minimal weekly lesson fee for service. Our goal is to give back to the servicemen and women that have so bravely served our country, therefore, most of the fees for programming will be covered by donations from individuals, and gifts and grants from the community.
