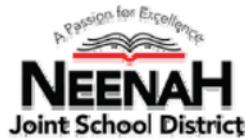

"Saddle Up for Success" and "Partners in Riding"

These two programs are run in collaboration with the
Neenah Joint School District

In ***"Saddle Up for Success"***, students from the Shattuck Middle School AIMS (Academic Improvement in School) program are taught in small groups how to retrieve a horse from the herd, groom, tack, and complete basic riding skills. They are then encouraged to become volunteers in the other BEAMING, Inc. programs to facilitate learning about horses, horse care, community involvement and healthy activities. Goals are to teach basic horse care and riding skills. Therapeutic benefits include improved balance, attention span, cognition, self-esteem, motivation, community involvement and healthy life choices.

"Partners in Riding", is a collaborative between BEAMING, the Neenah High School Health Careers Academy, and Neenah School District Elementary School children with special needs. Children with diagnoses such as Autism, Blindness, Sensory and Cognitive disabilities, Down Syndrome, and other neurological, developmental, orthopedic and sensory dysfunctions will be taught therapeutic riding skills by a Certified NARHA Instructor. Their volunteer side-walkers will be Neenah High School students, planning to go into health careers. The riding students will achieve goals as listed in programs 1-4 above. The high school students will achieve goals such as: interacting with children with special needs, observing non-traditional health care careers, and increasing awareness of community service opportunities.
